Position Purpose

The Certification Analyst is key to delivering Responsible Investment Association Australasia's (RIAA's) Responsible Investment Certification Program. In particular, the Certification Analyst works with RIAA members to complete certification and ratings applications, compiles the assessments and presents recommendations to the independent Certification Assessment Panel (CAP). This includes liaising with applicants, checking applications against the Certification Standard and undertaking due diligence of data included in applications.

Responsibilities:

The Certification Analyst is a key member of the Certification Team, which delivers the Responsible Investment Certification Program.

<u>Key responsibilities</u>

- Complete product certification assessment and present for approval to the Certification Assessment Panel
- Liaise with members to understand their priorities for certification and assist members with their certification application
- Use external research tools for portfolio analysis
- Analyse Certification Program data for KPI reporting and other uses
- Ensure accuracy and timeliness of data on the Program's data portal and <u>www.responsiblereturns.com.au</u>
- Provide administrative support to the Certification Program
- Assist in the development of assessment guidance notes
- Input into RIAA communications drawing on content from Certification Program, such as factsheets
- Other duties, as directed by the Head, Certification and Ratings

Selection criteria

- Ability to read and interpret public facing information documents such as Public Disclosure Statements, Information Memorandums, Stewardship reports and corporate websites
- Relevant tertiary qualification and demonstrated interest in responsible and ethical investment
- Highly developed research and analytical skills
- Excel, Tableau and/or database skills
- Experience with, or ability to learn, online research tools and platforms
- Demonstrated high level of detail and accuracy
- Good professional interpersonal skills, particularly spoken English language for engaging members by telephone
- Demonstrated ability to meet multiple, overlapping deadlines
- Ability to work within a team environment and across functional teams
